to the

LSG Amendment Report for HB 21

The analysis for Rep. Ken King amendment #851525 on page 43 of the Amendment Packet has been corrected to state:

This amendment seeks to add school districts established under Sec.11.351 that are operated by a general academic teaching institution to the Foundation School Program. This includes two ISD's of which were created by Texas Tech University and University of Texas. They are online and completely operated as a public charter. When they were created, they weren't added into the Foundation School Program and this amendment seeks to acquire them funding similarly afforded to other school districts.

The analysis for Rep. Moody amendment #851503 on page 75 of the Amendment Packet has been corrected to state:

This amendment creates a general provision to Chapter 42. Education Code, requiring the state to compensate a school district, a member of the board of trustees of a district, or a school administrator. In addition, an educator must also be compensated for any damages, costs, or attorney fees awarded in a lawsuit over state, or federal constitution violations resulting from the enactment of CSHB 21. The amendment further clarifies that this provision prevails over any other law in any conflict. This amendment would serve to protect citizens' state and federal constitutional rights in regard to any provisions set forth in CSHB 21 by prioritizing state, and federal liberties over any other law to the extent of any conflict.
