Cain 860530	This amendment adds a provision that would require that THC preserve monuments, memorials, statues, portraits, seals, symbols, structures and areas named after historic figures, groups or events. While it is the intent and responsibility of the Commission to preserve and promote history, the amendment language implies all aforementioned items or places named for historical figures or events and removes the discretion of the Commission as to where to appropriately invest resources.	Unfavorable
Martinez 860529	This amendment removes any language regarding the transfer of Port Isabel Lighthouse State Historical Monument from TPWD to THC. Constituents and stakeholders from the Port Isabel area have expressed concerns with THC taking over jurisdiction as the monument is unique in its functionality and is a critical cornerstone to the local economy.	Favorable
