<b>Cason</b> E870291	This amendment would prohibit the Prepaid Higher Education Tuition Board (PHETB) from implementing a policy that would benefit non-citizens of the United States. Additionally, the US resident status of the purchaser and the beneficiary must be included in applications submitted to the board. This amendment is directed at undocumented Texans and could make accessing education more difficult for those individuals.	<b><u>Unfavorable</u></b>
<b>Slaton</b> E870293	This amendment states for every rule imposed by the Prepaid Higher Education Tuition Board, two rules must be removed.
